Education Report

We hope to offer an on-the-water boat handling course in September. Details are still being finalized and will appear in the next issue of *Dredgings*.

Over the past year, 77 percent of fatal boating accidents were due to drowning and 75 percent were related to a failure to wear life jackets. Alcohol and drug use was the leading cause of boating re-lated deaths in 22 percent of adults and children. Coast Guard News Release June 15


