Storm King Power Squadron Jan. 2015 Annual Reports

It's been a very busy year since last January's nomination for the Commanders post. I assumed command at the March COW and was elected to the position of D2 Administrative Officer at the D2 Conference in April.

I presided over Storm King's Bridge and Executive Committee and General Member meetings throughout the year. I attended the D2 Winter and Summer Council meetings, and the D2 Spring Conference voting for the acceptance of the new district bylaws on behalf of Storm King. I attended the USPS National Fall Conference in Arlington, Virginia this past September.



I managed to marry my outstanding wife and fellow squadron member. We took a seven day instructional sailing cruise in the Grenadine Islands. We accomplished what we had set out to do by learning to sail in ocean deep water, and take the US Sailing Schools 101, 103, and 104 courses. This will allow us to charter boats in the future.

Throughout the year, I attended events hosted by neighboring Squadrons. This allowed me to see how they operate and conduct business, compared to Storm King. I went to a monthly meeting of Westchester Sail and Power Squadron. I observed a USPS sanctioned 'Practical On the Water' event that was held at the Shattemuc Yacht Club in Ossining, NY. The POTW course consisted of 3-4 hours classroom training, with the afternoon used for the students to have hands-on small power boat operation. I attended the 75th Anniversary celebration of the Mohawk Hudson Squadron.

This year, 2015, might be even busier for me. I will be going to the USPS National Conference, in Jacksonville, Florida on January 22 – 25, 2015. I will be attending the Greenwich Sail and Power Squadron COW on February 06, 2015. Then we will have SKPS COW in March, followed by the District 2 Spring Conference and COW in April. Gino Bottino, the current D2 Executive Officer will become D2 Commander, and I will be moving up to the XO position.

If all goes as planned, I will become the D2 Commander in 2016. Storm King will be the Hosting Squadron. We will need to appoint a committee shortly, to explore what venues in the area that could be used for a conference facility. The committee will need to develop and review activities that would be suitable for District and Squadron members to attend over a two day period. I will provide more information at a later date.

I wish all members, and their families a new year, that is active, healthy, and boating safe.

The Merit Marks application was completed and filed online for the fiscal year 2013-2014. The Chief Commander awarded SKPS 33 Merit Marks. The Budget committee prepared and submitted to the Executive Committee a recommended budget for 2015 which was approved by the Executive Committee at the December 2014 Executive Committee meeting.

Educational Officer Robert Trenz, AP

Two thousand and fourteen proved to be a very productive and rewarding year for the Education Department of Storm King Sail & Power Squadron. We provided numerous educational opportunities for the general public as well as our squadron members.

Lt/C Tony DiStefano, AP completed the **Sail** class that was started in the fall of 2013 administering the final exam and bringing closure to the class. **Advanced Piloting** began on 9 January 2014 instructed by P/R/C Dick Winchell, SN and assisted by P/C Phil Cameron, AP. Although there were only three participants the class was well taught and completed by his students.

The January 2014 General Member meeting speaker was author Kevin Woyce. Kevin has written several nautical theme books and gave an outstanding presentation on the **Lighthouses of the Hudson River**. And, in January the preliminary planning began for the **ABC3** boating safety course that was given in March.

February General Member meeting was dedicated to the initial presentation of **Operations Training** given by R/C Susan Darcy, JN.

The primary public education function of the squadron is the **ABC3** course. It was given on 29 March 2014. We had 30 students take and successfully complete the class that was superbly presented by the Squadron. A special thanks to P/C Tony Tucci, Jr P, P/C Phil Cameron, Jr., AP, Cdr Vince Evans, P, Lt/C Vingie Genco, AP, Nancy Trenz, P/D/C Martin Feldberg, AP, P/Lt/C Alexandra Digilio-Feldberg, AP, Lt/C Pete Skorewicz, Jr., P Lt/C Tony DiStefano, AP, and myself, Lt/C Bob Trenz, AP. In all the class was a huge success. Some recommendations were made to make the class more effective in the future.

At the June picnic we offered a "hands on" learning experience for the Squadron and Cornwall Yacht Club members and their families and friends on fire control and flare usage.

The September 17th General Member meeting was held on the **River Rose** with Captain and owner John "Duke" Panzella. We had our cruise catered and with the assistance of numerous Squadron members the trip was a huge success. With the unfortunate passing of P/R/C Richard Winchell, SN the squadron was able to pay tribute to Dick's unwavering dedication to United States Power Squadrons. Dick's good friend P/Lt/C Matt TenEyck, JN graciously offered to complete the **Advanced Piloting** instruction for the squadron.

Matt also consented to teach **Junior Navigation** for the Squadron. He traveled from Kingston for every class to accommodate our students. True dedication indeed.

We are now planning to have P/C Phil Cameron, Jr., AP teach **Weather** for the Squadron which we would like to start in February.

As the year came to a close the planning of our 2015 **ABC3** class must begin once again. Plans have



been made to have the offering on 21 March 2015. And so it begins once again.

Secretary Vingie Genco, AP

Storm King Power Squadron conducted 11 monthly Bridge and General Membership Meetings during 2014 (no meetings scheduled in July). Each of the Bridge meetings had formal minutes drawn up, reviewed at the following meeting and accepted by the Bridge for distribution to general membership the following month. These minutes documented all Bridge meetings attendance, incorporated detailed monthly Treasurer's and Educational reports, and covered all business transacted on behalf of the Squadron as identified by the Commander (or which was brought up for discussion and/or approval by the Bridge). In addition, Bridge meetings were open to any Squadron member wishing to attend.

The minutes also documented all District 2 and/or National Forms and Reports filed, including, but not limited to Safety, Budget, Audit, and History Reports, Educational Reports/Forms, Nominating Reports, D2 and National Meetings and SKPS attendance at same. The minutes also included a summary of the successful 2014 May SKPS Educational Auction, documented recipients of the 2014 SKPS Scholarships and the Memorial Scholarship, Merit Mark Reports, as well as the list of 2014 Officers and Committees/Members/Terms. The Secretary has a copy of the complete new SKPS By-Laws drafted and last approved in 2014, the SKPS Rooster with most recent telephone, mail and/or electronic contact information, and has filed all key correspondence received by her or provided to her by Bridge officers in 2014.

The secretary continued throughout 2014 to add the addendum section to the Bridge Mtg. Minutes to keep a more formal record of the following week's General Meeting Attendance and Subjects, Speakers, etc. to allow the Bridge to more easily collect information used for the history, safety, merit mark, and educational reports. The secretary also collected and has stored soft copies of all key reports/forms/inventory lists for complete and accessible Squadrons records. We have made several attempts to generate interest with little success. I need two week's notice in order to get the course materials here, so January 20, 2015 will have to be the last day to signup. We will send one last reminder.

USPS Founder's Day

USPS Operations Manual Section 11.53

By Governing Board resolution, “Whereas: United States Power Squadrons was organized on 2 February 1914, and through the succeeding years, in peace and war, has demonstrated its value and importance in the teaching of navigation, seamanship and good sportsmanship afloat; and Whereas: The ensign of United States Power Squadrons is recognized by the nautical world as a signal that the vessel flying it is under the command of a lover of the sea who is skilled, capable, trustworthy and law abiding; Now, Therefore,

Be It Resolved: That February second of each year be designated by the chief commander as Founders' Day, and that on that day throughout the United States recognition be given publicly to the work, growth and progress of United States Power Squadrons and to its founders”.

USPS Early History

...Roger Upton was a sailing member of the Boston Yacht Club in 1909 but, unlike so many other sailors, the newfangled powerboats captivated him. He owned a 50-foot ketch named Nirvana and often cruised up the coast to Maine.

Because he was a businessman, and because wind power was so often unreliable, he bought a 35-foot motor launch with a gasoline engine to serve as tender for the ketch and to tow her when she was becalmed. The following year he installed a 20-horsepower convertible kerosene-gasoline engine in the ketch, making it possible for him to return to his business on time. The reliability of power appealed to him and he grew to love power boating.

During the summer of 1912, twenty Power Boat Division vessels were invited to go with forty windjammers on the annual Boston Yacht Club cruise to Portland, Maine. The powerboats cruised in squadron formation with an elaborate system of maneuvers executed by means of flag signals. During the cruise a screeching nor'wester blew up. Many of the sailing yachts were dismasted or otherwise disabled. The power yachts under Upton's command went to their rescue, towing disabled craft to port. No losses were reported. To quote the September 1912 issue of Motor Boating Magazine, which dramatized the rescue with a six-page photo story, "The fellows of the Powerboat Division provided meritorious service and emerged from the ordeal crowned with glory.

"On 14 October 1912, a letter from Rear Commodore Roger Upton was read by the



Executive Committee of the Boston Yacht Club, petitioning the club to officially establish his Power Boat Division. As the minutes of that meeting disclose, the Executive Committee granted Mr. Upton's petition unanimously. At the annual meeting in January 1913, the name was changed to "Power Squadron" and the club-within-a- club was officially recognized...
