The *ABC3* course is set for 21 March 2015 at the 84 Diner in Fishkill, NY. The cost has been established at \$75.00 for the first family participant and \$50.00 for each additional family member that is willing to share the book. Fliers, posters, and YouTube Video have been printed and distributed to the Squadron members to publicize the course. I will finalize the instructor's assignments and meet with the instructors before we present the class. As of this time we have 10 students committed to the class. Let's get the word out.

Junior Navigation (instructor Matt TenEyck) has been completed by Vingie Genco and Jack Thomas Congratulations, both passed and are now Junior Navigators. I have secured the computer and projector from Matt. Matt will be the keeper of the sextants as of now. Any squadron member can contact him for their use.

Paulette Scheurer has completed and passed *Seamanship*. Congratulations, Paulette.

Matt TenEyek has requested that I order the instructional material for *Navigation* which I have done. The materials have come in and I have distributed them to Matt. He will look over the material with the possibility teaching the class for Storm King.

The *Weather* course had to be postponed until later this spring as the response was very weak. After several tries to generate interest in this very valuable course, the Squadron showed little interest. I have removed it from the USPS site. Phil Cameron has offered to wait until spring at which time we will re-offer the class and hope for a better response. I will poll the squadron and determine the level of interest in this course. Hopefully we can get members interested in participating.

Two years ago we offered a *First Aid /CPR/AED* class to the squadron. It is recommended that a refresher course be taken to keep participants current. I have contacted Richard Huff one of our members and one of the instructors of the course and he has consented to give the refresher course on March 5th 2015 at 6:00 at CYC. I notified the previous participants and have received responses from several that they are interested and will be participating in the class. The class was given (see photo above).

I have contacted the supervisor of the Sea Scouts and have scheduled them to come and do a presentation of their program for us at our April 9th 2015 general meeting. I will stay in contact with them and let's try to have a good turnout at our April meeting.


(PFDs) with the slogan, "Ready


