Bob Trenz will be notifying the instructors who need to be re-certified However, everyone may stay for the presentation.

I attended the District 2 Conference which was held at the Hyatt in Fishkill on October 17. One of the main topics was the adoption of a new budget for 2016. With declining revenue due to reduced membership, a thrifty budget was introduced and passed after a lengthily discussion. I received an award on behalf of SKPS. It was the Mel Cohen Safety Award for third place in effective communication for the publishing of The Crown by Wayne Garnsey. Wayne continues to be an outstanding resource to our Squadron. Bill Burbage was also recognized by Robert Terry in his preliminary report for Vessel Safety Checks. Storm King had the second highest number of VSC's with 43, which was 2 less than the 45 that Sacandaga recorded. Bill had submitted a total of 42 which was

the highest individual total. Awards will be presented at the Winter Council meeting in January 2016.

I have been meeting with representatives of the Ramada Inn in Fishkill to arrange the conference facilities for the D2 Change of Watch next year. The Feldberg's assisted Paulette and I in working out the suitable arrangements of meeting rooms, food, and lodging. My thanks to them as they continue support SKPS. BoatUS WINTERIZING CHECKLIST

OUTDRIVES

- If water intake is in lower unit, flush and run antifreeze through using muffs
- Drain gear oil and add fresh lubricant
- Inspect/replace anodes

BELOWDECKS

- Pump out holding tank and add antifreeze to head
- Drain water heater and bypass it
- Drain freshwater system and run antifreeze through it
- Run antifreeze through refrigeration, deck washdown pump, etc., per owner's manual
- Drain shower sump and other places where water pools
- Remove food
- Open lockers to air
- Take home cushions or store on their sides
- Take home portable electronics
- Close propane valves and take home portable canisters
- Verify bilge pump and switch operate properly
- Clean and dry bilges
- Secure all ports and hatches
- Turn off all circuit breakers

IN THE WATER

- Close all seacocks except for cockpit drains
- Plug exhaust ports
- Check docklines and chafe guards center boat in slip
- Add or adjust fenders for proper placement

BEFORE YOU GO

- Tie off tiller/steering wheel
- Cover/shrinkwrap boat
- Lock cabin and leave spare key with marina manager
